Robert F. Foster was deeply involved in the manufacturing industry beginning his journey in tool and die at the age of 18. It quickly became both his career and his passion, leading him to build two successful businesses within the industry. Robert joined TMA with his company, Laser Technologies in the early 1980s. He was a strong advocate for apprenticeship programs, particularly those aimed at enhancing the skills of young adults who were passionate about the industry. In his memory, Robert’s family has established an annual scholarship fund to carry on his legacy and support the values he held dear.

Foster Skilled Trades Scholarship is designed to promote and recruit promising individuals within the manufacturing sector awarding them a total of \$9000 across the 3-year span of their training.

- Written contract between student and employer detailing the parameters of the expectations of longevity and loyalty from student to their company by sending them through TMA’s Related Theory Apprenticeship Program (Not required, but recommended with employer’s best interest in mind)
